Order no. 968 of 28 September 2012 issued by the Danish Maritime Authority

**Order amending the order on Notice D from the Danish Maritime Authority,
technical regulation on the construction and equipment, etc.
of passenger ships engaged on domestic voyages**

Section 1

In order no. 556 of 26 May 2011 on order on Notice D from the Danish Maritime Authority, technical regulation on the construction and equipment, etc. of passenger ships engaged on domestic voyages, as amended by order no. 873 of 29 July 2011, the following amendments shall be made by authority:

1. After section 1 of the order, the following shall be inserted:

“Section 1a. Irrespective of section 1(1), all passenger ships engaged on domestic voyages shall have been approved by the Danish Maritime Authority before engaging in trade, either as a newbuilding or as bought from abroad. The Danish Maritime Authority may, as a precondition for granting such a permit, require that the passenger ship has a safety level corresponding to that contained in this or other set(s) of regulations.

Subsection 2. The provisions of subsection 1 shall not apply to warships and troop ships.”

Section 2

This order shall enter into force on 1 October 2012.
